# MESSAGE FROM STEVE DAVIS – CHAIRMAN RAFA HARTLEPOOL

At our AGM in February, there were no new nominations for Committee positions. Therefore, the Committee remains as was. However, if anyone would like to volunteer their services to assist the Committee with running the Branch, then please contact myself or the Branch Secretary. We would appreciate people to look at taking on Wings Appeal Organiser and assistance with Branch Welfare work. If you feel this might be something you are interested in doing, please contact the Branch Welfare Officer.

Last year our Branch managed to organise seven Wings Appeal collections at local Supermarkets and Shopping Centre. This also included participation at the Tall Ships Race 2023 where we manned a stall in the Military Village which was set up to cover the event over the 4 days the event was open to the public. Together with individual donations from members the Branch raised £5113 for RAF Associations Wings Appeal funds. This represented a lot of hard work by the small number of members who were available to assist with the collections.

# **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**

The meeting was attended by 14 members out of a registered membership of 256. There were very few apologies.

Both of our Welfare Officers are much in need of assistance. The Chairman gave the reports of Branch activities during the year and the Treasurer gave the audited accounts, all of which were accepted by the membership. There were no members resolutions and the Area Representative did not attend.

At the end of the meeting the members were informed that the social club will be closing its doors on a Monday evening at 8pm, due to lack of custom. After some discussion of alternative days and times the decision was made to remain with Ye Olde Durhams, and to start the meetings on Mondays at 6:30pm, to allow time for social activities before the building closes.

The Royal Air Forces Association (RAFA) is a membership organisation of serving and former members of the RAF, their families and dependents and all those supporting the aims of the Association. The Branch would welcome more ex RAF personnel and people who would be interested in supporting the Association in attending social events or assisting with collections in various locations. The Branch now covers an area from Seaham in the North to Whitby in the south excluding Stockton on Tees.

# **BOXING DAY DIP**

Branch member Maggie Lawlor, accompanied by her daughter, Kay and granddaughter, Freya, took part in the Boxing Day Dip at Seaton Carew to raise money for Wings Appeal. Registration at the Marine Hotel was quickly followed by the run to the sea at 11:30am. Over 600 people took part and more than one thousand supporters cheered them on. Given the size of Hartlepool Branch area; having absorbed the members of Seaham and Redcar Branches following closure, it is not always possible to keep in touch with all our more elderly and venerable members although we do make a big effort to do so. 
#### ANZAC MEMORIAL EVENT

# 80 YEARS ON — We Will Remember Them.

This year, 2024, sees two major 80th anniversaries. The Great Escape of 76 allied prisoners from Stalag Luft III took place on 24th March 1944. Of the escapees, 50 were executed on the orders of Hitler, and only 3 made the 'home run' to their respective countries.

The invasion of Europe on D Day, 6th June, is the other major anniversary this year, when allied land, sea and air forces breached the defences of Hitler's European Fortress and began the final phase of the war.
